




Definition of Entrepreneurship





Islam encouraged to venture into business


Islamic Entrepreneurship should operate within the domain of Islamic Economic system

Management Functions

Production	 Process of converting input into finish goods or preparing services
Human resources	 Consuming the skill/knowledge and effort of employee and management of the organization
Financial	 Process of collecting and allocating the usage of funds
Marketing	 A system of designing the mix of pricing, promoting, distributing product/services

"You are the best nation that has been raised up for mankind; You enjoin right conduct, forbid evil and believe in Allah" (Quran 3:110)


ethics governs all aspects of life
