Air Pollution

91% of the world's population live in places where air quality exceeds WHO guideline limit


In China, 98% of its cities exceeded WHO guideline


In India, in November 2019, a public health emergency was declared due to the air quality index of India exceeded 800 (more than 3 times of "hazardous" level)

In Indonesia itself, Jakarta has been several times ranked first in the city with the worst air quality in the world by AirVisual.





Distribution of global greenhouse gas emission by economic sector

Trend of Global Carbon Emission






Trend of global carbon emissions from fossil fuels from Change in energy related CO2 emissions by region, 1900-2014 2018-2019








Example of Climate Change Effects

Australia's Bushfire 2019

Climate change can 'supercharge' wildfires in Australia through more extreme heat, drought

Climate experts say Australia's hottest, driest year has made the fires worse.



Australia fires burn through 15 million acres of land, kill at least 25 people

Australia's Bushfire 2019




- Thousands of buildings and homes were destroyed

Liquid Waste Contributes to the Water Pollution

Citarum River was called as the world's most polluted river by the World Bank, yet about 28 million people in Indonesia rely on Citarum River in West Java for water.

Waste Problem in Indonesia



Every day, Indonesia generates 175,000 tons of waste and about 14% or 24,500 tons a day of plastics.

Unfortunately, currently 81% of waste in Indonesia is unsorted.



Plastic Pollution in the Ocean



- To overcome this problem, some cities in Indonesia have started banning single-use plastic bags.

 No. 142/2019 (single-use plastic bags in Jakarta)
