Air Pollution

91% of the world's population live in places where air quality exceeds WHO guideline limit

In China, 98% of its cities exceeded WHO guideline

In India, in November 2019, a public health emergency was declared due to the air quality index of India exceeded 800 (more than 3 times of “hazardous” level)


In Indonesia itself, Jakarta has been several times ranked first in the city with the worst air quality in the world by AirVisual.





Distribution of global greenhouse gas emission by gas




Change in energy related CO2 emissions by region, 2018-2019





Climate change means a significant change in the measures of climate, such as temperature, rainfall, or wind, lasting for an extended period – decades or longer.



- Huge damages in farmland



Waste Problem in Indonesia



Every day, Indonesia generates 175,000 tons of waste and about 14% or 24,500 tons a day of plastics.

Unfortunately, currently 81% of waste in Indonesia is unsorted.
